Facts	What does Smackover State Bank do with your personal Information?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the products or services you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security Number and Income • Account Balances and Payment History • Credit history and transaction or loss history <p>For Mobile Banking we may also collect the following information regarding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Location • Contacts • Camera <p>When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in the notice.</p>
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Smackover State Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your accounts(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus.	Yes	No

What we do	
How does Smackover State Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit sharing only for <ul style="list-style-type: none">• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness• affiliates from using your information to market to you• sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you• State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Smackover State Bank does not share with our affiliates.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Smackover StateBank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Smackover StateBank doesn't jointly market.
